RODEO ENTRY PROCEDURES

PLEASE READ: Completed Membership applications and fees must be received prior to the first rodeo you enter! Please be sure THAT YOU HAVE MAILED ALL THREE OF THE MEMBERSHIP FORMS TO THE STATE SECRETARY PRIOR TO ENTERING!! You will not be able to compete in any rodeo until every item is completed and approved by the Secretary.

1. You must be a member in good standing in order to enter.
2. Rodeos are based on a **one-day event**. Each day you enter must have complete and submit a separate entry form. For example, the Payson Rodeo is scheduled for Saturday and Sunday. **You need to send in one entry form for Saturday as well as Sunday; however, you may include all fees on one check.**
3. Complete the first page of the entry form by selecting the events that you will be participating in.
4. Complete the top section of the Waiver of Liability and have parents signature notarized. Only one parent must sign this form. You may use one Waiver of Liability form for a 2 day Rodeo.
5. Take this page of the form to the Member's school and have one of the following sign the form to verify that the Member is meeting the Eligibility Requirements (grades and conduct): Superintendent, Principal, Counselor.
6. Mail all of the forms (COMPLETED) and a check (may be a personal check) to Patsy Alexander, Rodeo Secretary, P.O. Box 369, Marana, AZ 85653.
7. Entries are due 17 days prior to the rodeo date, but Rodeo entries will be accepted until 15 days prior to the Rodeo with a \$25.00 late fee. **RODEO ENTRIES WILL NOT BE RETURNED IF POSTMARKED AFTER 5 DAYS PRIOR TO THE RODEO.**
8. There will be a \$25.00 fee for incomplete entries as well.

Entries and money are due and must be postmarked (no metered mail) two and a half weeks (17 days) prior to the first day of the rodeo. It is your responsibility to submit **both sides** of Official Entry Form for all High School Rodeos on time with all proper signatures, notaries, membership numbers, and money. Any entries postmarked less than 15 days from day of rodeo will not be accepted and returned. **NO EXCEPTIONS! Fee of \$25.00 will be assessed for all late or incomplete entries. Draw out time is 48 hours** before the rodeo with a charge of **\$25.00**. No refunds after 48 hours unless a doctor's or veterinarian's release is submitted with official signature on official letterhead by 6:00 p.m. of the day following the rodeo. The secretary must be notified before the end of the rodeo that a medical release is coming. There will be a **\$25 returned check fee** and you will be required to enter with a money order or cashier's check at all future rodeos. **National and State membership applications and dues must be postmarked (no metered mail) to the State Secretary, Heather Tripp on or before the entry due date of the first entered rodeo for 2009-2010.**

BOTH SIDES OF ENTRY FORM MUST BE COMPLETED FOR EACH RODEO – even if you are 18 years old.

ATTENTION—When entering the State Finals Rodeo, both sides of entry form must be completed and YOU MUST ALSO BRING ONE OF THE FOLLOWING TO THE RODEO OR YOU WILL NOT COMPETE:

- **An official High School Transcript showing the completed 2nd semester grade report.**
- **Your report card showing the completed 2nd semester grade report including final exams.**
- **A letter on school letterhead from your school stating that you have passed 4 classes for the year.**

An official of the school must sign your report card or your letter.
