June is our driest month. Campfires and charcoal are not allowed. You may bring a gas grill if you choose.

Adult Beverages & Glass Containers

The consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited at the facility. Additionally, please do not bring any type of beverage in a glass bottle.

Tow Away Zones

Please help us to keep the Fire Marshal happy. No vehicles can be parked within 20 feet of the 4,000 sq. ft. tent or bleachers. Please adhere to the NO PARKING signs. It is a safety precaution that we have access at all times. If you violate this request, YOU WILL BE TOWED.
